

Fundraising tips

Looking for inspiration?

Here are some ideas our fundraisers made earlier!

#1

Host a Toilet Twinning meal and auction – we can provide framed twinning certificates to auction off. Just ask us for a sale-or-return fundraising kit with 10 or 20 Toilet Twinning certificates, loo rolls, info sheets and more!

#2

Find (a clean) toilet and invite people to 'spend a penny' by throwing loose change in the bowl. Put on a performance, eg busking, or an activity, eg face-painting, rub-on tattoos.

#3

Do a sponsored event (eg run, kayak, silence, head shave) wearing a Toilet Twinning T-shirt. We can send you a small, medium, large or XL.

#4

Sign up for a cycling endurance event and we'll send you a Toilet Twinning cycle jersey, which is free if you set yourself the challenge of raising £500 or more.

#5

Hold a toilet-related games night! (like 8th Carlton Scout Group did!) and your group might find itself getting stuck into: – dodgeball with loo rolls – mummification-by-toilet-paper contest – toilet roll ten-pin bowling etc.

Hold a fancy-dress contest with costumes made out of toilet paper and toilet rolls and perhaps one other specified material (eg tape).

Hold a Posh Loo Day at school or work – providing luxuries such as handcream and sweets in the toilets – and invite donations in a (clean, disconnected) toilet bowl (with thanks to The University of Law for idea no.5)
