

# Toilet Twinned Town accreditation scheme



## Goal 1:

- Your local council or MP has twinned their toilet – or accepted a guerrilla twinning.

## Goal 2:

Your village has **ONE** toilet twin in at least **FOUR** of the following categories:

- Churches or other faith communities
- School or other educational establishments
- Public toilets or toilets made available to the public through the Community Toilet Scheme\*
- Cafés, pubs or restaurants
- Local businesses / employers
- Community organisations / charities

\* Certificates need not be displayed, just accepted

## OR

Your town has **TWO** toilet twins in at least **FOUR** of the following categories:

- Churches or other faith communities
- School or other educational establishments
- Public toilets or toilets made available to the public through the Community Toilet Scheme
- Cafés, pubs or restaurants
- Local businesses / employers
- Community organisations / charities

## Goal 3:

- At least **ONE** toilet in your village and town has been twinned by means other than guerrilla twinning by your steering group, and as a result of your promotion efforts. You can show us how you have made efforts to promote Toilet Twinning in your community (eg through flyers, invitations, events, making presentations/school assemblies etc).

## Goal 4:

- You have achieved media coverage for your efforts – or can provide evidence of attempts to do so. (This will provide welcome publicity for all businesses and organisations involved, as well as for the Toilet Twinning cause.
